SheTechTalks is dedicated to empowering young women (aged 18-30) with the skills and confidence to excel in the digital world.

The Learning Programme of the Academies includes the development of four Digital Training Academies. Each academy offers:

- flexibility in learning paths, by offering at least 7 sessions, so learners may select six of them
- The **first and last sessions** of each academy are **compulsory** and will include more synchronous learning activities
- The **other sessions** are **offered independently** from each other, and can be selected and completed in any sequence. They include more asynchronous learning activities.

The academies follow the principles of **self-directed learning**, and successful completion of an academy is rewarded with a **micro-credential**.





Objectives of the Training Academies

Offering opportunities for professional development and entrepreneurial learning to young women

Counselling and mentoring of young women, contributing to intergenerational learning

Contribute to the digital transition, while making tech educational programs more inclusive and accessible.

Empower young women to overcome stereotypical thinking and contribute to bridging the gender divide.







Required commitment

A learner needs to complete 6 sessions with a total workload of 14 hours. In total, an average of 84 hours

The majority of hours will be asynchronous learning activities, allowing flexibility

- Synchronous learning activities in Q&A sessions. Learners will ask questions, answered weekly by trainers in a forum
- Should the Academy be successfully completed, participants will be awarded with a micro-credential.




